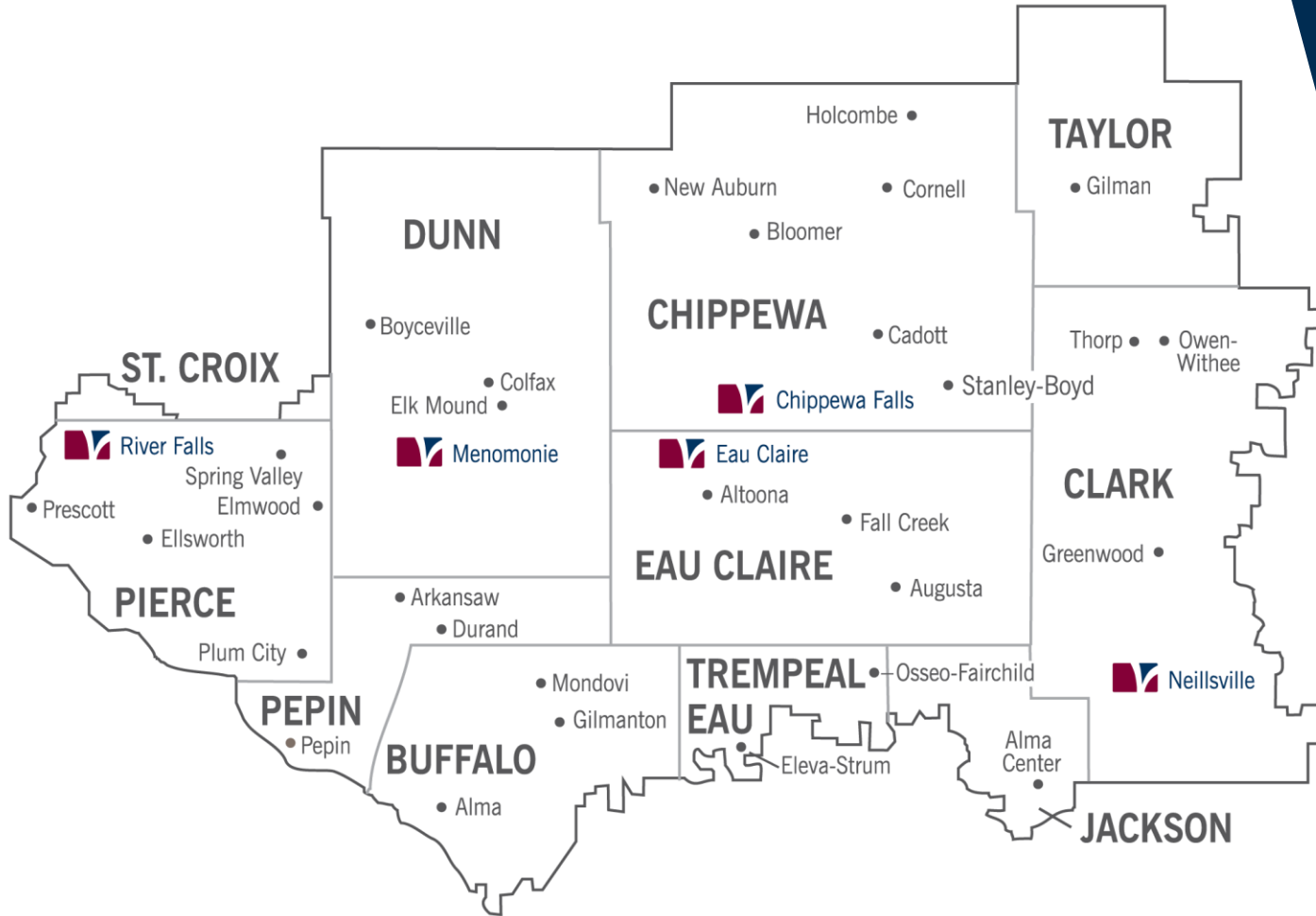

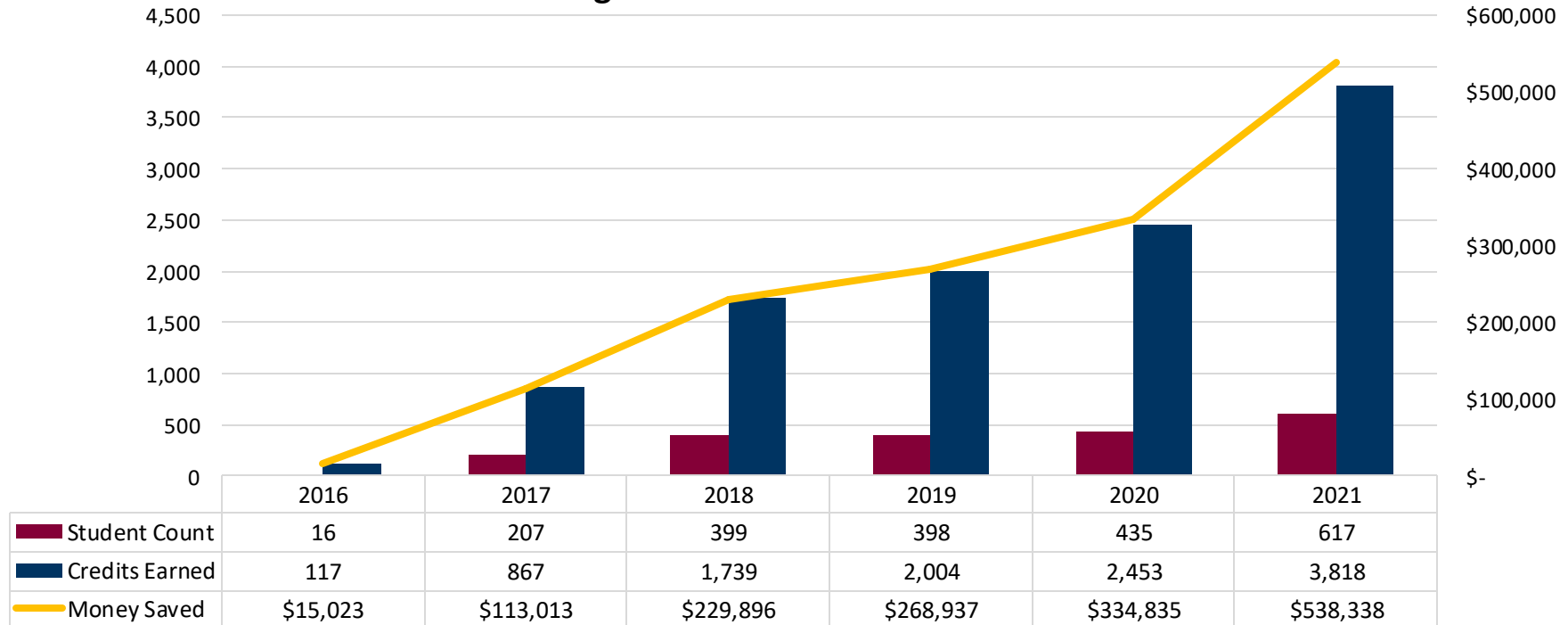

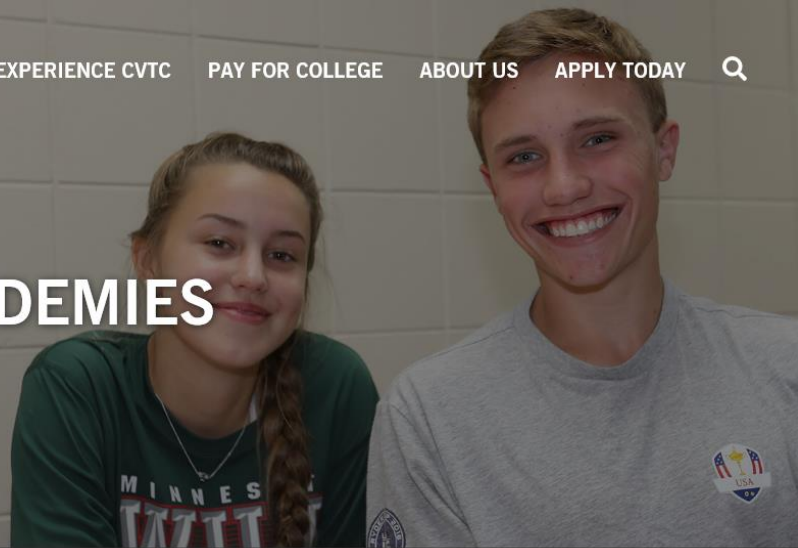

- \$1.7 Million US Department of Education two-year grant for rural, virtual, and innovative access
- Grant Goals
 - Expand Healthcare, College Transfer, & Business Management Associate degree to a virtual option
 - Provide rural and disadvantaged students wrap around services
 - Goal: Serve 190 students 2021-2023
 - 2021: 82 students enrolled
 - 136 applied for 2022-23
